

St. Paul's is committed to providing worship opportunities to ensure all have an opportunity to safely worship. Below you will see different ways to worship and what to expect at each service. **Newly updated information is highlighted in yellow.** We will continue worshipping in our sanctuary along with continuing to stream worship on our Facebook page.

9:30 AM Indoor Worship

Masks	St. Paul's Council encourages face mask wearing for all individuals—fully vaccinated and unvaccinated. It is most important to <u>wear a well-fitted mask</u> correctly that is comfortable for you and that provides good protection. This encouragement applies to all indoor gatherings and meetings in our buildings at St. Paul's. Disposable surgical masks and KN95 masks are available for your use, prior to entering the sanctuary.
Distancing	When sitting near non-household members; we continue to ask you to distance, sitting every other pew, keeping a minimum of a 6-foot distance in any direction.
Communion	Communion will continue to be distributed via disposable communion kits
Fellowship after worship	Instead of our coffee hour after worship: We invite and encourage you to <u>visit with one another, immediately after worship, on our outside deck area.</u> For the time being, we will not be offering coffee, instead help yourself to a bottle of water as you leave the sanctuary, and visit outdoors.
Bulletins	Weekly bulletins are emailed out by Saturday of each week and also found on St Paul's Website—please bring with you to worship. Our indoor worship service can be viewed on our screen via PowerPoint, so bulletins may not be necessary for some.
Offerings	Offering container is available as you enter the worship space for placing your offerings before or after worship. Offerings can also be donated online anytime during the week, for those , coming to in-person worship, who prefer to donate online .
Ventilation	Windows and doors will be opened to allow for ventilation
